

# CRAFTS TO GO

## Wood Slice Ornament

**Materials included:** Wood slice, paint, twine, beads, toothpick and a paint brush.

**Materials needed:** none

### Instructions:

1. First you will need to decide what design you would like to put on each side of your ornament. Practice drawing it on a piece of paper. (You could also make a label like “Clean” and “Dirty” for the dishwasher or “Tea” and “Lemonade” for a drink dispenser.) You have two paint colors. Add additional colors of your own if you like. We used acrylic paint.
2. Use the flat tipped paint brush to paint a circle background color on one side. (See black color on Figure 1) Let dry. Repeat on the other side.
3. Draw your design with pencil on each side, then paint over it. (Make sure the paint is dry on one side before moving to the other.
4. Thread the twine through the hole in the ornament.
5. Thread the beads (both pieces of twine at once) and push them to the bottom of the twine, next to the wood slice. (See Figure 2)
6. Tie a knot at the top of the twine. (See Figure 3)
7. Find the perfect place to hang your new creation!
