

# CRAFTS TO GO

## Salt Shaker Snowman

**Materials included:** Salt Shaker, Styrofoam Ball, Imitation Snow, 3 Buttons, Tinsel Garland, 2 Black Pins (eyes) and an Orange Toothpick (nose)

**Materials needed:** scissors, glue or hot glue

### Instructions:

1. Remove the silver cover to the salt shaker.
2. Locate your imitation snow and fill the salt shaker with it. (Make a funnel with a piece of paper.)
3. Put a row of glue on the top edge of the salt shaker and glue down the styrofoam ball (head).
4. Put a row of glue on the bottom edge of the silver cover to the salt shaker and glue down the hat to the styrofoam ball (head).
5. Take the tinsel garland and cut off a 1 inch piece. Glue this to the hat. Glue a button on top of this.
6. Take the rest of the tinsel garland and wrap the neck of the salt shaker with it. Go around twice and tie off the end.
7. Glue down the two remaining buttons vertically to the bottom half of the salt shaker (see picture).
8. Locate your two black pins and insert them into the styrofoam ball for eyes.
9. Locate your orange toothpick and insert it into the styrofoam ball for a nose. Glue if necessary.
10. Enjoy your little Salt Shaker Snowman!
