Clay Pot Snowman

Materials included: Clay pot, white puff balls, spoon, floral foam, tissue, felt, paint, toothpick and tie

Materials needed: Hot glue (recommended) or tacky glue, scissors

Instructions:

1. Turn your clay pot upside down. Paint the lower half of your pot blue. Let dry. (Figure 1)
2. Using a toothpick and white paint, draw snowflakes on your blue pot. Make a few large snowflakes and fill in some of the empty spaces with white dots (snow). Let dry. (Figures 1 and 3)
3. Using the other end of your toothpick, paint blue dots on the white part of your pot. Let dry. (Figure 3)
4. Cut two slits on both ends of your blue scarf. Tie the scarf to the spoon and make both ends go to one side. Glue if necessary to hold it up so that it looks like it is blowing in the wind. (Figures 2 and 3)
5. Take the small rectangular blue piece of felt and glue it into a circle. This will be the hat. Glue the hat to the fat end of the spoon. Tie the hat in the middle with the orange/white tie. Trim the tie if you wish.
6. Insert the floral foam (green) into the pot, pushing it all the way to the bottom. (Figure 2)
7. Insert the spoon into the floral foam, pushing it down until it stays there. (Figure 2)
8. Take the tissue and wrap it around the floral foam and spoon, hiding all the green. Glue the tissue to keep it in place.
9. Glue the three snowballs in a pyramid in front of the spoon and on top of the pot. (Figure 3)
10. Enjoy your snowman in a clay pot!
