

# CRAFTS TO GO

## Hand Painted Canvas

**Materials included:** One 8 x 10 Canvas, Paint in 3 colors (grey, blue, pink), Paper Plates (3), Paper (3)

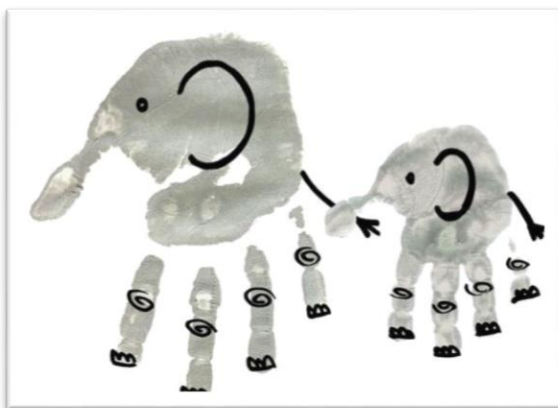
**Materials needed:** Black Sharpie or Black Marker

**Instructions:**

Decide which pattern you would like to make. The Elephant Hand Print or the Hand in Hand Print.

1. For the Hand in Hand Print...Have the largest adult/child go first. Pour the grey paint onto a paper plate. Place his/her palm and fingers in the paint. Try making a print on a piece of paper for a trial run. Re-dip your palm in the paint. Place the palm on the canvas in the middle with fingers spread. Let dry completely. (You may use a hair dryer to speed up the process.)
2. Repeat step two with the next largest adult/child in a different color. Let dry completely. Repeat until all members have finished. Use a sharpie to date if desired.
3. For the Elephant Hand Print...Turn the canvas sideways to give you more room to work.
4. Pour grey paint onto a paper plate, immerse the palm of your hand and place it onto a piece of paper for practice. Dip hand in paint again and place it on the canvas. Repeat for child. When dry, use a black sharpie to draw the details.
5. Hang it proudly in your home or office or give as a gift to someone special!
