

# CRAFTS TO GO

## Winnie-the-Pooh Catch Cup Game

### Materials Included:

*Yellow cup*  
*String*  
*Bee*  
*Yellow cardstock paper*  
*Black pompom*

### Materials Needed:

*Scissors*  
*Tape*  
*Black marker (Sharpie works best)*  
*Glue*



### Directions:

1. Draw Winnie-the-Pooh's face onto the cup using a marker.
2. Glue the black pompom onto your cup for the nose.
3. Draw two round ears on yellow cardstock paper and cut them out.
4. Glue or tape the ears to the inside of the cup so that they stick upward.
5. Thread one end of the string through the hole of the bee. It's very tiny!
6. Tape the other end of the string about halfway or more inside the cup. Hot glue will work as well, we just want to be sure the string is secure enough to play with! You may cut the string with scissors if you feel it is too long.
7. Enjoy the new game you've made! Hold the cup with one hand and try to swing the bee to where you can catch it inside the cup!
